# ANTI-CORRUPTION (AMENDMENT) ACT 2019

## 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Anti-Corruption (Amendment) Act 2019*.

## 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day appointed by the Minister by *Gazette* notice.

## 3 Anti-Corruption Act 2018 amended

This Act amends the *Anti-Corruption Act 2018* (the “principal Act”).

## 4 Amendment of section 11

Section 11(6) of the principal Act is repealed and replaced with the following:

- “(6) In addition, the nominating committee may nominate a person for appointment or re-appointment as chairperson of the Commission if the person is at the time of nomination:
- (a) qualified for appointment as a judge of the High Court of Solomon Islands; or
  - (b) a retired judge of the High Court of Solomon Islands; or
  - (c) eligible for appointment as a judge of the High Court of Solomon Islands but is otherwise over the retirement age for judges of the High Court of Solomon Islands.”
