AN ACT to amend the Gaming and Lotteries Act (Cap. 32).

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

- Short title. 1. This is the Gaming and Lotteries (Amendment) Act 1982.
- Increase in permitted prizes, ticket costs and total value of certain lotteries and Minister's power to impose conditions. (Cap. 32)
2. Section 9(2) of the Gaming and Lotteries Act is amended -
- (a) by replacing paragraph (c) by -

“(c) except with the prior written consent of the Minister no prize shall exceed \$1,000 in amount or value and no ticket or chance shall be sold at a price exceeding \$2.00;”;
 - (b) in paragraph (g) -
 - (i) by inserting at the beginning “except with the prior written consent of the Minister”; and
 - (ii) by replacing “one thousand five hundred dollars” in both places it occurs by “\$3,000.00”;
 - (c) by adding a new paragraph at the end -

“(n) in giving his consent under paragraphs (c) and (g) of this subsection the Minister may in writing impose such conditions as to the conduct, administration, accounting procedures and audit of the lottery as he thinks fit.”.
