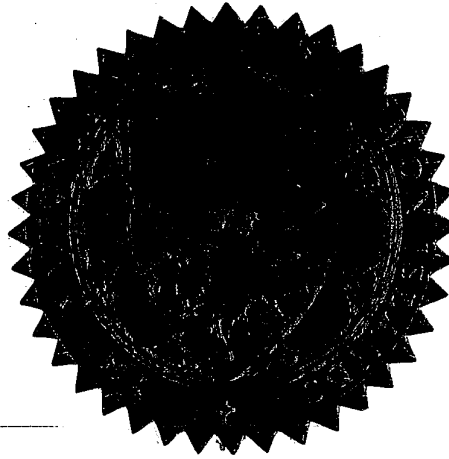

1983 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1983

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1983 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1983.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of three million nine hundred seventy six thousand and seventy five dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1983.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule.

4. In the second Schedule to the 1983 Appropriation Act 1982, in column 1, for "\$10,000,000" (Development projects in natural resources, economic infrastructure and human resources) substitute "\$20,000,000".
