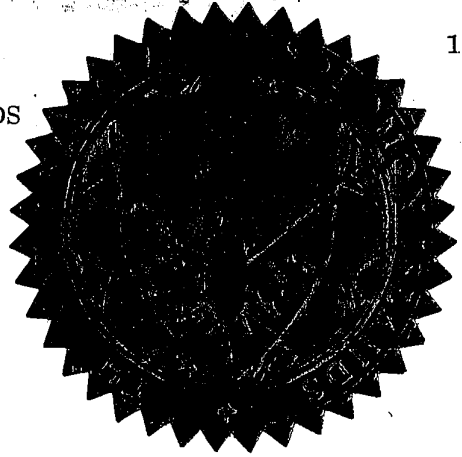

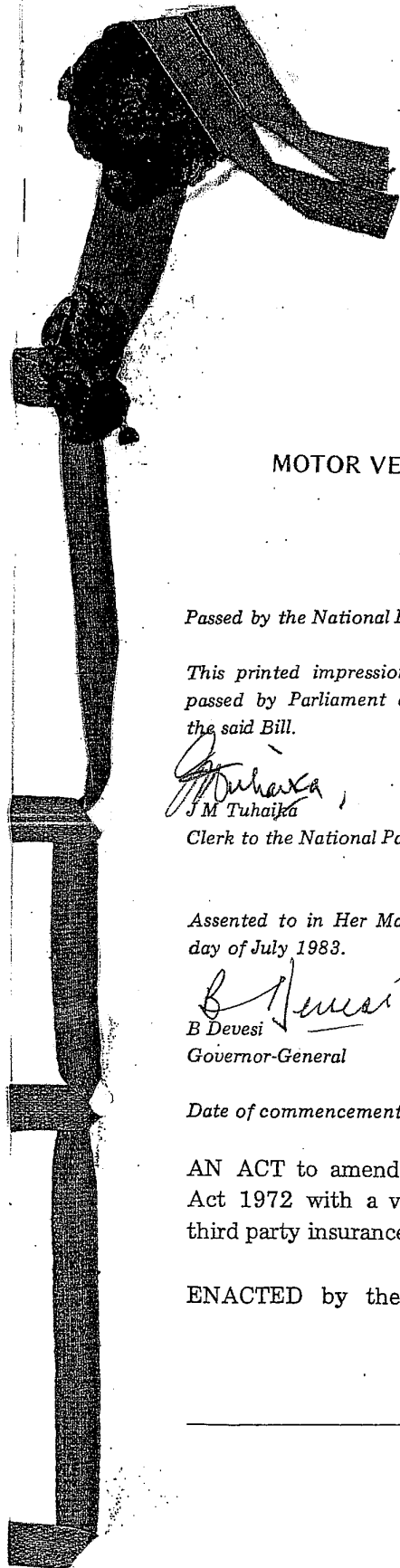

AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act 1972 with a view to increasing the limit of liability under third party insurance policies.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.



Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance)(Amendment) Act 1983

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance)(Amendment) Act 1983, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of section 4 No 16 of 1972.

2. Section 4(3) of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act 1972 (hereinafter called the "principal Act"), is hereby amended by deleting the words "a notice of".

Amendment of section 5.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by substituting for subsection (2), the following subsection -

"(2) The amount of liability insured under a third party policy issued on or after the date of the commencement of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Act 1983 may be limited to sixty thousand dollars in the case of any one accident or series of accidents arising out of one event."
