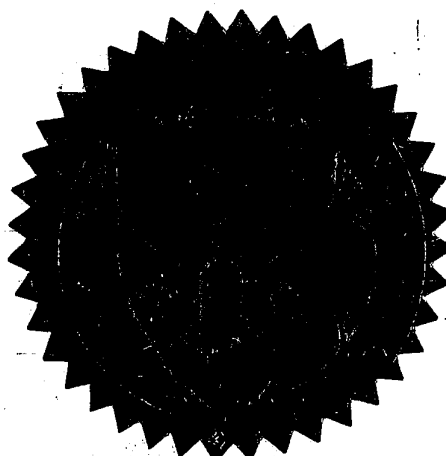

AN ACT to repeal the Parliamentary (Conditions of Service) Commission Act 1979.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

*The Parliamentary (Conditions of Service) Commission
(Repeal) Act 1983*

Short title
and
commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary (Conditions of Service) Commission (Repeal) Act 1983, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, appoint.

Repeal of
Act No. 2
of 1979.

2. (1) The Parliamentary (Conditions of Service) Commission Act 1979 is hereby repealed, and the Parliamentary (Conditions of Service) Commission established and functioning thereunder is hereby dissolved.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal or dissolution, all things done, and actions taken, by the said Commission, including the Financial Rules drafted or recommended by the Commission and approved by Parliament, as in force, on the date of such repeal, shall continue in force till the date on which the regulations made by the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission established under section 69A of the Constitution come into force.
