AN ACT to amend the Essential Services Act.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Essential Services (Amendment) Act 1986.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

Amendment of S.2(7)(a) of Cap.22 as amended by Act No. 5 of 1976.

2. Section 2(7)(a) of the Essential Services Act is amended by inserting immediately after the words "air transportation" the expressions "immigration, meteorology, customs and excise, quarantine, broadcasting, post office, Treasury Division of the Ministry of Finance".
