(NO. 10 OF 1990)

AN ACT to Appropriate fourteen million seven hundred and twentytwo thousand two hundred and thirty-six dollars forty-eight cents to the service of the year ending 31st December 1989.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1989 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1990.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund \$14,722,236.48 to the service of 1989.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of fourteen million seven hundred and twenty-two thousand two hundred and thirty-six dollars forty-eight cents to be applied to the service of the year ending December 31st 1989.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule to this Act.
