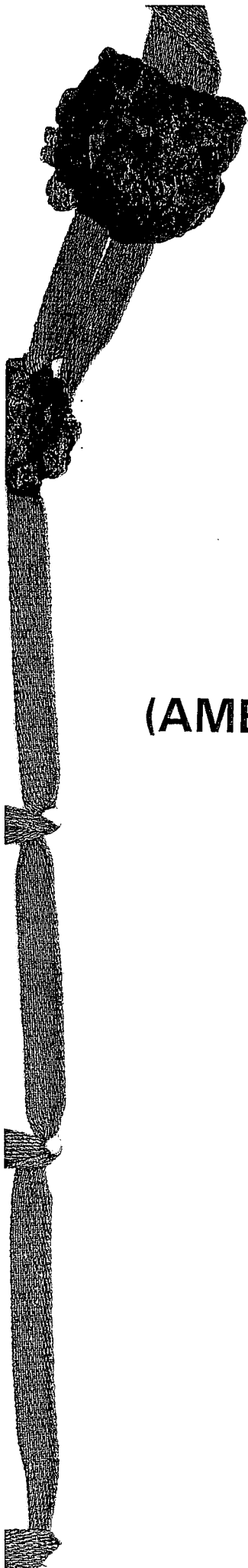

AN ACT To Amend the Research Act, 1982.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Research (Amendment) Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may appoint, by notice published in the Gazette.

2. The Research Act is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 3 the following new section as section 3A -

“Exemption. 3A. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act the Minister may by order exempt any person or class of persons from the requirement of section 3.”
