AN ACT To Appropriate forty one million five hundred and eight thousand seven hundred and eighty five dollars to the service of the year ending 31st December 1995.

Enacted by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

This Act may be cited as the 1995 Supplementary Appro-Act 1995.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$41,508,785 to the service of 1995.

The issue from the Consolidated Fund hereby authorised of the sum of forty one million five hundred and eight thousand and seven hundred and eighty five dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1995.

Appropriation.

The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for supply of the heads specified and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule to this Act.
