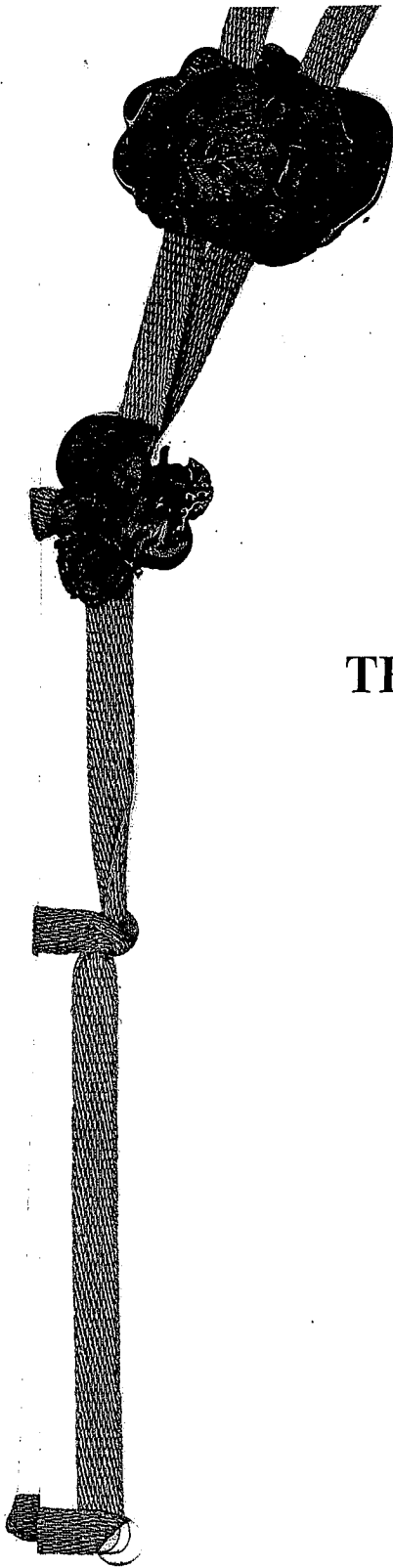



AN ACT To Repeal the Debit Tax Act 1995.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Debit Tax (Repeal) Act, 1996.
