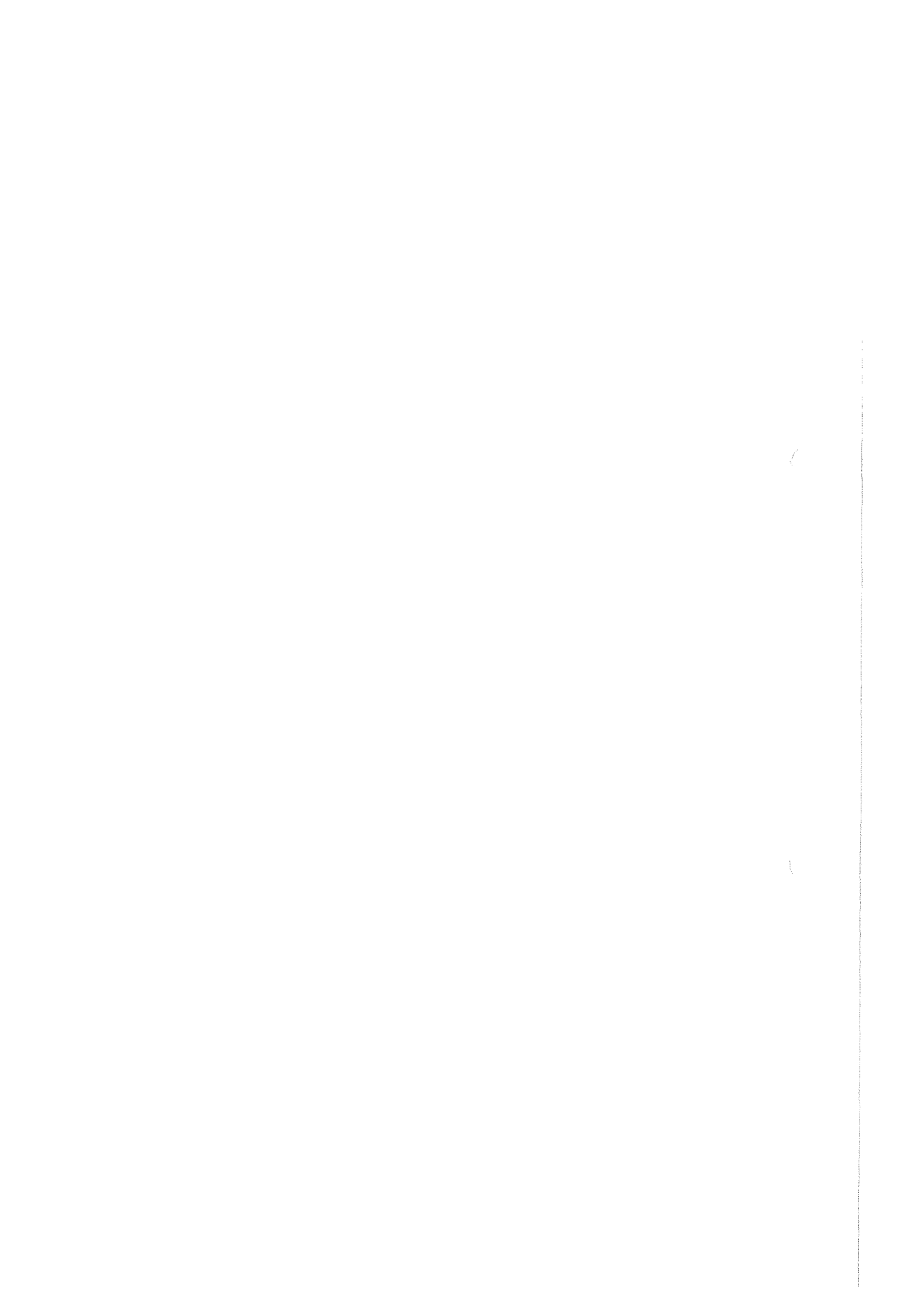

BILL

ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY FIVE MILLION TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN DOLLARS TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER 2000.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the 2000 Supplementary Appropriation (No.3) Act 2003.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund
\$125,264,917 to the service of 2000

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of one hundred and twenty five million two hundred and sixty four thousand nine hundred and seventeen dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 2000.

Appropriation

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule to this Act.

Explanatory Notes

The above are overspendings by respective heads at the closing of accounts for the year ending 31st December 2000. The overspendings were inevitable as the government began working towards peace in a rather fragile process. This supplement is to appropriate for these overspendings as per section 19 of the Public Finance and Audit Act (Cap 120). THE 2000 SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (NO.3) BILL 2003

Objects and Reasons

The object of this Bill is to authorise supplementary expenditure of one hundred and twenty five million two hundred sixty four thousand nine hundred and seventeen dollars incurred to the service of the government under certain Heads of Expenditure in respect of the year ending 31st December 2000 in addition to the expenditure on those Heads authorised by the 2000 Appropriation Act 1999 and the 2000 Supplementary Appropriation Act 2000. The Schedule contains the amount required to be authorised in each Head.
